

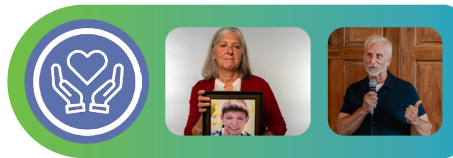
Envisioning a world without blindness

Eversight facilitated **76** training and education sessions to **787** surgeons, fellows, residents, coordinators, eye bankers and other clinicians, so they can restore sight to more people throughout their careers.
